Our Gym: Our gymnasium hosts many volleyball and basketball activities, including all home games for the Lutheran High Lynx basketball and volleyball programs. Our gym averages anywhere from 250 - 600 visitors each week, with the most during basketball season (December - March). Families from all over the valley attend events in our gym each week. It is also used by LHS and other Lutheran schools and groups for performances, concerts, music and fine arts fairs, summer athletic camps and many, many more events throughout the year. Our gym receives more foot traffic than any other place on campus.
